

## *Call for Papers and Posters*

The *Scaphirhynchus* Conference will be held at the Embassy Suites Hotel-St. Louis Downtown on January 11-13, 2005. All aspects of Alabama sturgeon, pallid sturgeon, and shovelnose sturgeon biology will be open for presentation. For more information concerning the conference (abstract preparation information, currently submitted abstracts, etc.) see our web site: <<http://bio.slu.edu/mayden/conferences/sturgeon.html>> The conference will provide an opportunity for academia, federal and state resource agencies, and other professionals to discuss ideas, research, education, and conservation concerns. Formal 20-minute (15 min. presentation + 5 min. questions and answers) “PowerPoint” presentations will be presented on January 11-12, starting at 8 a.m. and ending at 5 p.m. The 13th will be reserved for a “working session” on Research and Assessment Needs to Restore Pallid Sturgeon. A poster session will also be scheduled. An ice-breaker will be held the evening of the 10th in the lobby – free drinks if you’re staying at the Embassy Suites. A Banquet with a guest speaker (Inga Saffron, author of *Caviar*) will be held on Tuesday the 11th. Authors of selected presentations will be requested to prepare a formal paper for a book on the genus *Scaphirhynchus*.  
**Remember, your abstract is due by October 1, 2004.**



### *Conference Location*

Join your colleagues at the *Scaphirhynchus* Conference at the Embassy Suites Hotel – St. Louis Downtown. The Embassy Suites has set aside a block of rooms for the conference at the government rate (approximately \$100.00 per night). The Embassy Suites is located on the banks of the Mississippi River at “The Landing”, a steamboat era warehouse district that has been turned into a restaurant and nightclub district with cobblestone streets, gas lights, horse and buggy rides, and sidewalk cafes.
